8. Adroddiadau'r Cynghorwyr Sir / Reports from County Councillors.

(a) Y Cyng. Catrin Miles

- (i) Mae SBWRIEL yn dal i fod yn fater sy'n codi pryder yng nghanol y dref. Trefnir casgliad y bagiau duon bob tair wythnos, ac eto mae rhai pobl yn eu rhoi allan yn syth ar ôl casgliad – sy'n golygu eu bod allan am dair wythnos, gydag adar ac anifeiliaid yn eu rhwygo am fwyd. Mae'r Cyng. Miles, pobl leol a swyddogion CSC yn ceisio datrys y broblem ond, wrth reswm, mae ganddynt faterion eraill ar y plât ar hyn o bryd. Fodd bynnag, mae hyn yn fater iechyd a diogelwch digon gofidus.
Mae achosion hefyd o wasgaru sbwriel anghyfreithlon ym maes parcio Stryd y Cei. Mae un busnes yn mynd â gwastraff cardfwrdd yno'n rheolaidd a'i adael ger y cist casglu papur gwast. "Name and shame" bydd hi, os yw hyn yn parhau!
Mae pobl yn gadael dillad hefyd, er nad yw'r blychau'n cael eu gwacáu ar hyn o bryd.
- (ii) STRYDOEDD BRWNT: Mae'r sefyllfa wedi gwella rhywfaint o ganlyniad i aelod o'r cyhoedd brwsio'r baw i'r hewl. Fodd bynnag, croesewir cynnig gan gwmni lleol i olchi'r manau gwaethaf – gan nad yw CSC yn gweithredu rhaglen o lanhau'r strydoedd ar hyn o bryd.
- (iii) GWIRFODDOLWYR: Mae'r grŵp lleol yn Aberteifi (*Cardigan - Corona Virus Help*) yn gweithio'n arbennig o dda, yn cydlynu gweithgareddau gyda CAVO a CSC ac yn dangos sawl enghraifft o arfer da – sy'n cael ei rannu gyda grwpiau eraill ledled y Sir.

- (iv) **BLYCHAU BWYD:** Y gobaith yw o ddechrau mis Mai ymlaen y bydd CSC yn medru ailgydio'n y broses o ddsbarthu blychau bwyd gyda chynnwys mwy lleol na'r rhai sydd wedi cyrraedd o Lywodraeth Cymru.
- (v) **YSGOLION/ADDYSG:** Mae CSC yn cyfarfod yn rheolaidd gyda phennaeth pob ysgol gynradd ag uwchradd yn y Sir. Bydd rheini'n cydlynu rhaglen o waith ar gyfer pob disgybl tra'u bod yn astudio o gartref.
- (vi) **PRYDAU YSGOL AM DDIM:** Oherwydd rhai anawsterau gyda thalebau i brynu bwydydd mewn archfarchnadoedd, mae'r Awdurdod wedi trefnu taliadau uniongyrchol i deuluoedd plant sy'n haeddu prydau ysgol am ddim – hyd yn oed trwy wyliau'r Pasg. Bydd hyn yn parhau hyd nes i'r ysgolion ailagor. Nid oes dyddiad wedi ei benodi hyd yma.
- (vii) **FEIRWS CORONA:** Mae grŵp penodol o swyddogion CSC yn gweithio ar raglen "Contact Tracing". Bydd hwn, ynghyd â rhaglen Profi ("Test, Trace & Quarantine") yn hwyluso ailgydio mewn rhyw fath o normalrwydd maes o law.

(b) Y Cyng. Elaine Evans

- (i) Derbyniwyd adborth positif i wefan CSC, yn cymeradwyo'r wybodaeth sydd ar gael oddi ar i'r Feirws Corona dorri allan. Mae'n ffynhonnell dda o wybodaeth sydd yn galluogi cynghorwyr ei dosbarthu yn y cymuned.
- (ii) Yn dilyn fy nghais i'r cyngor sir, rhoddwyd Gerddi Fictoria o dan glo oherwydd cwynion fod pobl ddim yn dilyn rheolau ymbellhau'r llywodraeth.
- (iii) Derbyniwyd cwyn gan aelod o'r gymuned ynglŷn â dronau, a'u bod yn amharu ar breifatrwydd yr unigolyn. Bydd rhaid monitro'r sefyllfa.
- (iv) Pobol ddim yn cadw at ganllawiau ymbellhau cymdeithasol – mae sawl esiampl o hynny yn creu pryder yn y gymuned. Mae adeiladwyr sy'n gweithio yn agos i dai eraill yn anwybyddu'r canllawiau diweddaraf. Awgrymir y dylir anfon adroddiad o bob enghraifft at yr heddlu.
- (v) Mae'r Cyng. Evans wedi gofyn am rodd ariannol oddi wrth Ffrindiau Ysbyty Aberteifi i Fanc Bwyd Aberteifi. Disgwylir ateb mewn da bryd.
- (vi) Tipio sbwriel anghyfreithlon – Mae App newydd "Clear Waste" ar gael sydd yn galluogi'r cyhoedd i adrodd am digwyddiadau trwy ddanfôn lluniau yn syth at yr Awdurdod Lleol. Disgwylir ymateb oddi wrth CSC am eu hymateb i'r cynllun.

(a) Cllr Catrin Miles

- (i) REFUSE is an ongoing issue, causing concern in the town centre. Black bag collection rules are often disregarded, with people putting them out almost immediately after collection, which means that they are out for almost three weeks, with birds and animals tearing bags that contain any food waste. With local people and CCC officers, Cllr Miles is pursuing the issue but is aware that officers have a huge workload at present. Nevertheless, this is a serious Health & Safety issue, and is being addressed.

There are cases of fly-tipping, particularly in the Quay Street car park. One local business persists in taking packaging/cardboard down to the site on a regular basis, leaving it outside the collection box. If this continues, it will be a case of "name and shame"! Bags of clothing are also being left, even though containers are not presently being emptied.
- (ii) STREET-CLEANING. The situation has improved somewhat, due to a member of the public brushing dirt from the pavement onto the street. However, the offer by a local company to pressure-wash the worst areas is most welcome, particularly since CCC is not operating a street-cleaning programme at present.
- (iii) VOLUNTEERS: the local group (Cardigan - Corona Virus Help) is working extremely well and coordinating activities with CCC and CAVO (Ceredigion Association of Voluntary Organisations). They are showing several examples of good practice that are being rolled out throughout Ceredigion.

- (iv) **FOOD BOXES:** From 1st May onwards, it is hoped that CCC can once again take control of supplying box-contents, using local suppliers, for distribution to those who are “shielding”. Feedback indicates that people much prefer the CCC boxes to those distributed by the Welsh Government.
- (v) **SCHOOLS/EDUCATION:** The CCC Chief Education Officer is in regular contact with Primary and Secondary head-teachers who, in turn, coordinate a programme of study for all pupils whilst they are home-educated.
- (vi) **FREE SCHOOL MEALS:** Due to some problems with the voucher-system, CCC has reverted to direct payments to the families of children eligible for Free School Meals, even throughout the Easter holidays. This system will continue until such a time as schools re-open (No indication of date, as yet.)
- (vii) **CORONA VIRUS:** a group within CCC is working on a “Contact Tracing” programme. This, along with Testing (“Test, Trace & Quarantine”) is vital in the process of resuming some semblance of normality in due course.

(b) Cllr. Elaine Evans

- (i) Positive responses have been received for the CCC website, since the Corona virus outbreak, commending them on the information available. It is a good source of information for councillors to distribute in the community.
- (ii) The Victoria Gardens gates were locked on Cllr Evans’ request to CCC due to people using it and not social distancing.
- (iii) A complaint was received from a member of the community regarding drones, perceived as being an invasion of privacy. The situation will continue to be monitored.
- (iv) People not complying to social distancing – there are several areas for concern in the community. For example, builders continue working in close proximity to other houses and not obeying new guidelines. It is recommended that any such issues be reported to the police.
- (v) Cllr Evans has requested a financial donation to the Cardigan Food Bank from the Friends of Cardigan Hospital. A response is awaited.
- (vi) Fly tipping –Cllr Evans is looking into a new App called Clear Waste enabling members of the public to report occurrences by sending photographs to their Local Authority. The involvement of the county council in the scheme is awaited.

12. Unrhyw Fater Arall ar ddoethineb y Maer.

- (a) **Mae'r cyngor yn ddiolchgar i Mr John Morris am ddefnyddio ei ddoethineb i drîn planhigion a phorfa ger y senotaff, yn enwedig gan ei fod yn ddiwrnod Cofio 75 Mlynedd Diwedd yr Ail Rhyfel Byd ddydd Gwener, 8 Mai.**
- (a) The council is grateful to Mr John Morris for using his initiative by maintaining the grass and plants at the cenotaph, especially in preparation for the 75th Anniversary of Victory in Europe Day on Friday, 8th May.
- (b) **Glanhau'r strydoedd – Cytunwyd gofyn i Mr Marc Thomas lanhau palmant y Stryd Fawr (gan gymryd y camau angenrheidiol i gadw'n ddiogel) gan ddechrau ger Castell Aberteifi i fyny at ardal Pendre. Gofynnwyd iddo adrodd yn ôl a rhestru i'r cyngor yr adeiladau sydd â'r broblem fwyaf o safbwynt carthion colomennod sydd yn anharddu'r palmentydd fel y gellir datrys y broblem i'r dyfodol**
- (b) Street cleaning - It was proposed that the council request Mr Marc Thomas to carry out this service (using the necessary protection), focusing on the High Street pavement, from Cardigan Castle to Pendre. It was also requested that Mr Thomas prepares a report stating where pigeon excrement is at its worst allowing the council to inform CCC of the main business property offenders, enabling pressure to be placed upon owners to rectify the problem in future.
- (c) **Tipio sbwriel anghyfreithlon: Yn anffodus, oherwydd y sefyllfa, nid oes llawer y gellir ei wneud i ddatrys y broblem ar hyn o bryd. Gobeithio y bydd gwasanaethau'r cyngor sir yn ailweithredu'n fuan. Gofynnir i'r cynghorwyr annog y cyhoedd i fod yn wylidwrus ac i adrodd yn ôl i'r heddlu. Y clerch i ddanfôn rhestr o'r lleoliadau lle gwelir sbwriel anghyfreithlon ar hyn o bryd er mwyn i'r cyngor sir flaenoriaethu arnynt pan ddaw'r sefyllfa presennol i ben.**
- (c) Fly tipping: Unfortunately, nothing can be done to resolve the situation at the present time. It is hoped that county council services will be back on line soon. Councillors are requested to advise the public to be vigilant and report incidents to the police. Clerk to send email with list of current incidences to CCC in order to prioritise the areas when lockdown is lifted.
- (d) **Grŵp Feirws Corona Aberteifi: Cyfrannwyd £210 gan y Maer, y Cyng. Shan Williams, i gefnogi'r gwaith da a gyflawnir yn lleol gan y Grŵp. Mae'r Dirprwy Faer, y Cyng. Clive Davies, wedi darganfod noddwr lleol sydd yn barod i gyflenwi peiriannau cerdyn yn rhad ac am ddim i'r Grŵp. Cynghorwyd y Grŵp hefyd sut i sefydlu menter gymdeithasol a rhannwyd gwybodaeth am y grantiau sydd ar gael i'w cadw'n weithredol yn y dyfodol.**
- Nodwyd bod y Cyng. Richard Jones a'r Dirprwy Faer wedi trafod â Laura Winter am drefniadau ar gyfer symud un diffibriliwr dros dro i ganol y dref. Archebwyd yr uned, sydd wedi ei leoli yng nghwrt Neuadd y Dref, yn 2016 gan y Cyng. Clive Davies yn ystod**

blwyddyn ei faeroliaeth. Mae'r Cyng. Richard Jones yn edrych am gabinet addas i'w leoli. Cytunodd Laura Winter gymryd cyfrifoldeb am yr uned yn ystod y trefniant dros dro.

- (c) Cardigan Corona Virus Group – The Mayor, Cllr Shan Williams, recently donated £210 in support of the good work the Group is carrying out locally. The Deputy Mayor, Cllr Clive Davies, has also been supportive through acquiring card machines free of charge from a local sponsor, advising how to set up a social enterprise, and collecting information on the grants available for funding, enabling the Group's future existence. It was noted that Cllr Richard Jones and the Deputy Mayor have discussed with Laura Winter regarding the temporary relocation of one defibrillator in the town centre. The unit was donated by Cllr Clive Davies during his mayoralty year in 2016, and is located in the Guildhall courtyard. Cllr Jones is sourcing a suitable cabinet. Laura Winter will take responsibility for the unit during the temporary arrangement.
