Cyflwyniad / Presentation: Mr Ben Cramp – “Soap Box Derby” (hand-built go-karts). This is a fund raising event for Cardigan Cancer Care, also bringing together local organisations: Scouts, ATC, Coleg Ceredigion, Sport Clubs, Schools, etc.

The proposed routes at the Bath House link road and the Pentood Industrial Estate were discussed. Other matters included the following: road closure, first aid, toilets, barriers, post event celebration, insurance, risk assessment, judges and funding. The following dates were suggested: 7, 14, 28 August and 4 September.

All members present were in full support of the proposed event and the Mayor thanked Mr Cramp for his most informative presentation of a potentially exciting and entertaining event and wished him well with his plans.
