## **Croeso'r Cadeirydd / Chair's welcome**

Croesawodd y Maer, y Cyng. John Adams-Lewis bawb i'r cyfarfod.

Cyfeiriodd at farwolaeth chwaer-yng-nghyfraith y Cyng. Siân Maehrlein a fu farw'n ddiweddar. Estynnwyd cydymdeimlad y cyngor iddi yn ei thristwch o golli dau aelod agos o'i theulu mewn byr amser.

The Mayor, Cllr John Adams-Lewis, welcomed everyone to the meeting. He referred to the passing of Cllr Siân Maehrlein's sister-in-law, Sue, and offered the council's sympathy to Siân following her second bereavement of a close family member within a very short period.

## **Cyflwyniad / Presentation**

**Ymddiriedolwyr ac Aelodau Ffrindiau Maes Sgrialu Aberteifi.**

Trustees and Friends of Cardigan Skateboard Park.

Two members of the trustees/committee, Wozza and Dan, attended the meeting and gave a short presentation of the latest developments at the park. Concern was expressed at the grant shortcomings due to the Brexit crisis. With the able assistance of Ms Cathryn Morgan, the county council is seeking bids from reputable and experienced contractors to upgrade the surface of the skateboard arena. The surface is in a poor state of repair, showing cracks and considerable wear and tear. The park is leased by the county council to the town council who is responsible for its management and maintenance. Cllr Clive Davies is the town council liaising member. Ms Morgan is presently in contact with Flexcrete, a specialist firm who has supplied detailed specification for the concrete repair and surfacing. Prestec UK will provide further guidance and a budget costing for carrying out the work in accordance with the specification. The grant awarded by the Big Lottery Fund of £4,704 in November 2017 will need to purchase the following before the deadline of May 2019: a skateable memorial bench, bin, etiquette sign, grind rail and a bowl drain lid. If there is surplus money, it will be used for the drainage surrounding the park. The total funding available is £56,600 (80% European funding, 20% match funding from Cardigan Town Council). The two representatives wished to appreciate the support and practical cooperation of both Ms Cathryn Morgan and Cllr Clive Davies. The Mayor thanked Wozza and Dan for the update and wished them well with their aspirations for the improvements at the Skatepark which will greatly benefit both local users and visitors alike.

**Awgrymwyd bod y mater yn cael ei drafod yn is-bwyllgorau Ebrill. Yn y cyfamser, cytunodd y Cynghorwyr Clive Davies a Graham Evans ddilyn llwybr y map i archwilio'r lleoliadau.**  
It was recommended that the matter be discussed at the April sub-committees. In the meantime, Councillors Clive Davies and Graham Evans agreed to review the suggested locations as mapped.

It was also recommended that the council requests a bin be placed at Rhodfa'r Felin as the expected increase in footfall will occur with the opening of the integrated health centre.

Pigeon faeces on the High Street and Pendre.  
Please find response from Gareth Payne, the county council Housing and Environmental Control officer. E-mail has been downloaded to members.  
The county council states that it has no statutory duty to take action against property owners where gulls or pigeons are causing problems, and in most cases has no legal powers to force owners or occupiers of buildings to carry out work to their buildings to prevent birds from nesting, even if they are causing problems. The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 is the principal legislation dealing with the control of birds. It states that it is illegal to capture, injure and destroy any wild bird or interfere with its nest or eggs. In practice, there are very few humane methods to kill gulls or pigeons and skill and experience is needed to deploy them. There is no statutory duty placed on the council to control seagulls or pigeons.
